

Searcy City Council – Special Session
Monday, November 5, 2007 – 5:00 p.m.
Minutes


Mayor LaForce called to order the Special Session of the Searcy City Council. City Clerk Tammy Gowen called the roll with the following answering “present”: Mary Ann Arnett, Jim Dixon, Kyle Reeves, Dale English, Jackie Liles, and Mike Chalenburg. Mr. Carl Nutter came in late. Also present was City Attorney Buck Gibson. Alderman Mark Derrick was absent.

The only item on the agenda was a budget ordinance amending the budget by appropriating \$88,100 from unappropriated reserves to a new capital expense account (5-090-53-14) to be called 2007 Boom Truck to purchase a 2007 International Boom Truck from Henard Equipment Company for the Sanitation Department. The ordinance was read in its entirety. A motion was made by Mr. Nutter and seconded by Mr. Reeves to suspend the rules and place on second reading. Motion passed with the following voting “yes”: Arnett, Dixon, Reeves, English, Liles, Chalenburg and Nutter. Following the second reading a motion was made by Mr. Nutter and seconded by Mr. English to further suspend the rules placing the ordinance on third and final reading. Motion carried with the following voting “yes”: Dixon, Reeves, English, Liles, Chalenburg, Nutter, and Arnett. Following the final reading the Mayor asked, “Shall the ordinance pass?” Upon roll call the following voted “yes”: Reeves, English, Liles, Chalenburg, Nutter, Arnett and Dixon. A motion was then made by Mr. Nutter and seconded by Mr. Chalenburg to adopt the emergency clause. Motion carried with the following voting “yes”: English, Liles, Chalenburg, Nutter, Arnett, Dixon, and Reeves. **Ordinance 2007-39-A**


A motion was made and seconded to adjourn.
